The work is novel and interesting in the prototype. However, the title does not reflect the content. Although this work is innovative, it is not useful in this time to be lacking in basic research in the design of the device; the heating time and cooking of food is very long and not analysis of the state of the art of solar cooking was performed. It is required to explain in detail the thermal model of the system; it is suggested to mention the thermal efficiency of the prototype, the optimum operating conditions and make a comparative analysis with other solar cookers. the methodology for the implementation of these solar cookers is not mentioned; to quantify the benefits that this technology generates a larger number of prototypes required implemented. No mention cooking time of food, which can be an important comparative indicator. If the job title suggests a technology healthy and economic, the content does not mention the payback period of the investment of technology and the possible reduction of conventional fuels. It is suggested that the author treats all recommendations for acceptance.
